



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between



**Defence Infrastructure Planning & Management Council of India
(DIPM Council of India)**

AND

**Delhi Chapter of Indian Society of Heating, Refrigerating and Air Conditioning
Engineers (DCI)**

1.0 Preamble

This Memorandum of Understanding is being signed between DIPM Council of India located at B-333, Chitaranjan Park, New Delhi 110019

And

Delhi Chapter of ISHRAE (Indian Society of Heating, Refrigerating and Air Conditioning Engineers), referred to as DCI, located at 502, DDA Building, Laxmi Nagar Commercial Complex, New Delhi-110092, with their HQ located at K-43 (Basement), Kailash Colony, New Delhi 110048.

This comes into effect from the date of signing of MoU.

1.2 DIPM Council of India

DIPM Council Of India has been established under the aegis of DIPM Society which is a registered society, not for profit organization working in the field of Infrastructure technology innovations, development, Project Management, Contract Management, project delivery, skilling India in the field of Infrastructure in general and Defense Infrastructure in particular in the Government Sector.

The cadre of IDSE officers involved in the defense Infrastructure planning and management shall be the key stake holders in the council in their personal capacity on honorary basis purely in academic interest besides members from academic institutions, infrastructure companies, Consultants, technical bodies, PSUs, autonomous bodies, private individuals, Govt. officers etc. on voluntary basis. The council will hold periodic seminars, technical discussions as well as publish technical journal to keep pace with technology development and innovations.

1.2.1 DIPM Council of India Aims & Objectives

The main objective of the DIPM Council of India is to ensure safer technology in every area of human life related to defense of human beings from unsolicited/ unknown risks in the environment. This includes reducing risks to human life and enhanced safety from enemy action or faulty and unsustainable practices in infrastructure planning/ design and execution, safety of work force at places of work, safer road design, road and vehicular safety etc.

1.3 ISHRAE

ISHRAE is the premier Indian society in the HVAC &R field with approximately 10,000 individual member's pan India dedicated to advancing the arts & sciences of heating, ventilation, air conditioning and refrigeration to serve humanity and to promote energy efficiency and sustainable building development in India. ISHRAE serves its members through 40+ Chapters across the country.

To fulfill its objectives, ISHRAE organizes seminars, conferences, workshops and exhibitions throughout India; publishes a Technical Journal, Handbooks, Guidebooks, Standards and Position Papers; promotes research through co-operation with Academic Institutions and Industry. Its education and training branch, the ISHRAE Institute of Excellence (IIE) conducts courses and training to groom professionals for a career in the HVAC&R field.

1.4 ISHRAE Aims & Objectives:

- Advancement of the Arts and Sciences of Heating, Ventilation, Air Conditioning and Refrigeration Engineering and Related Services.
- Continuing education of Members and other interested persons in the said sciences through Lectures, Workshops, Product Presentations, Publications and Expositions.
- Rendition of career guidance and financial assistance to students of the said sciences.
- Encouragement of scientific research.

2.0 MOU Objectives

- DIPM Council of India & the Delhi Chapter of ISHRAE, have joined hands as Industry Associations who are keen to work together and create a common platform to share



knowledge and help their members learn from Industry experts from both these Associations.

- DIPM Council of India & DCI to exchange information on the latest developments in their respective areas that are of common interest, and jointly work in conducting programs to benefit the members of the Building Services Industry with focus on HVAC&R.
- The Industry concerns related to climate change, environmental responsibility, energy efficiency, IAQ, safe & sustainable workplaces that can be addressed by the HVAC&R Industry will be given importance and attention.

3.0 Areas of Cooperation

- **ACREX India** is the annual event of ISHRAE & one of the largest exhibitions in South East Asia, which attracts exhibitors and visitors from all over the world from the HVAC& R and Building Services Industry.

DIPM Council of India will give due publicity to ACREX India by posting one promotional page on their website. DCI will reciprocate by promoting DIPM Council of India exhibition and conference.

- Each organization will provide one free advertisement in their Journal/Newsletter or mail e-advertisement to their members, on a reciprocal basis.
- Each organization to encourage their local exhibitors to participate in each other's Expositions.
- ISHRAE & DIPM Council of India will consider sending Speakers with domain expertise to one another's Conferences/Seminars to facilitate cross-flow of knowledge.
- Each party will invite the President /CEO to each other's major conference each year. If the President or CEO is not able to attend, an alternative may be nominated.

3.1 Education & Training

- DIPM Council of India will authorize ISHRAE to promote DIPM Council of India learning programs by offering these courses to ISHRAE members at concessional



rates.

- DCI will welcome DIPM Members to attend DCI organised Education & Training Programs.

3.2 Publications

- DCI and DIPM Council of India will make their publications available to the members of the two organizations at concessional prices.
- Use of all vehicles to promote sales of publications will be considered, including displays at meetings, listings in catalogues, online promotions, and advertisements or announcements in periodicals.
- **ISHRAE publications**
 - **Printed Books & eBooks:** ISHRAE will provide DIPM Council of India a list of their Publications available. These books will be offered to DIPM Council of India Members at the same price as is applicable to ISHRAE members plus actual courier charges. In the case of eBooks, ISHRAE shall offer viewing rights to all DIPM Council of India members on a subscription basis, at the price applicable to ISHRAE members. Reciprocal access to DIPM Council of India publications will be provided to all ISHRAE members on the same terms as applicable to DIPM Council of India members.
 - **Newsletter:** Each organization may provide news of events and activities to the other organization for possible inclusion in their various publications and online information sources.
- **Joint Articles- DIPM Council of India** would support the development of joint articles on the issues that concern DIPM and Indian HVAC&R industry. These articles shall be available to the other society for printing & distribution among their members.

3.3 Websites & Information Exchange

- DIPM & DCI shall provide from their websites a link to the other organization's website, and opportunities will be considered to mutually exploit this communication medium.



3.4 Liaison Committee:

- A Liaison Committee comprising a representative of DCI and another representative from DIPM Council of India shall hold a meeting, either via Conference call or at any other pre-arranged venue at least once in six months, to implement the MoU and explore more Areas of Cooperation. The names of the representatives shall be mutually finalized later.

3.5 Policy Statements and Position Statements

- Each organization may be given opportunities by the other to comment on proposed policy and position statements developed on technical subjects. If further collaboration is considered to be mutually beneficial, those opportunities will be explored.

3.6 Membership & Networking

- Members of one Society can attend Conferences and Events of the other Society on the same terms as applicable to the members of the host Society.
- DIPM Council of India & DCI will both encourage Members of their Society to apply for the membership of the other Society.

4.0 Govt. Representation & use of Logos

- This MoU shall not be construed as creating a partnership, joint venture, principal-agent, or any other relationship of any kind between DIPM Council of India and Delhi Chapter of ISHRAE, and both are free to exercise judgment & discretion with regard to the conduct of their respective businesses.
- DIPM Council of India or ISHRAE will not make any representation to any Government / Statutory Body on behalf of each other, unless the same has been specifically approved in writing by the competent authorities in the two Associations.
- Neither Party will be held liable for acts of omission or commission of the other Party, with respect to anything agreed upon under this MoU. The rights and responsibilities established shall survive indefinitely the termination of this Agreement.
- This MoU recognizes the fact that both DIPM Council of India & ISHRAE trademarks are widely known throughout India & Overseas. The association of



the ISHRAE trademark with any event brings to that event the benefit of heightened awareness and prestige. The use of ISHRAE trademark has therefore to be authorized by ISHRAE. Indiscriminate use of Logo is prohibited, and it is necessary to seek prior approval in writing detailing the context of usage, from the other Party, before using their Logo.

5.0 Tenure and Termination


This MoU between DIPM Council of India & DCI shall be valid when signed by the authorized representatives of both parties and shall continue until it is terminated by mutual consent or by either party on serving a written thirty days' notice to this effect.

The MoU may be renewed, modified or amended by mutual written consent of both the Associations.
